ASC of WA ENTRIES: Pre-Entries must be postmarked between June 10, 2008 & June 25, 2010. ALL STOCKDOG ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IN POSTMARK ORDER except that entries received more than 10 days after the postmark date will be accepted by receipt date. Day of entries added on must pay day of entry fees. No refunds will be made if the show/trial cannot open due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of the ASC of WA. Entries must be on an official ASCA form with the agreement signed on the back. Information must be complete, legible, and indicate the day and whether AM or PM of competition. No mail will be accepted without waiver of signature and will be returned if this is not done. Entry fees may be refunded if an owner presents the show committee with a letter from a veterinarian stating the entry should not participate due to health reasons. Refunds must be re- requested prior to start of the show. **Each dog's entries for ASC of WA events can be on**

the same form, multiple copies are not needed! Entries for all shows, except CASCADE, are to be sent to **Michelle Berryessa, PO Box 519, Roy, WA 98580.**

DIRECTIONS to Pierce County Fairgrounds (Frontier Park): From I-5 take exit #127 onto HWY 512. Travel Eastbound on HWY 512 to Eatonville-Mt Rainier exit. Turn right onto HWY 161 (Meridian). Travel south for approximately 10 miles. Frontier Park is on the right side of the road.

POLICIES: An official waiting list will be maintained. A draw for run order will be made prior to the trial. If an owner pulls an entry, and that space can be filled from the waiting list, a refund shall be made. Substitution of a dog owned or co-owned by the same owner is allowed. Bitches in season shall run in order. Other breeds wishing to compete for ASCA titles must have an ASCA tracking number. This number can be applied for day of trial.

POLICIES: Juniors may compete with any breed, however for ASCA points in the merit programs, the dog must be an Australian Shepherd and must meet ASCA Junior ownership requirements. The Junior must be an ASCA Junior Member.

POLICIES: All Australian Shepherds must have an individual ASCA registration number to compete, except non-regular puppies, which must be eligible for ASCA registration.

We are offering the new non-regular classes throughout the day. Dogs ARE allowed to compete in the Wildcard classes, Seniors and a regular class during the same trial.

Regular group exercises will be held first (Open first, then Novice). Open V, B & A and Novice B & A group exercises may be combined. Non-regular group exercises will be held after the individual exercises.

Friday AM: Utility V, B & A Open V,B & A, Novice B & A Wildcard – Utility, Open and Novice.

Friday PM: Utility V, B & A Open V,B & A, Novice B & A, Seniors and Sub-novice

Saturday AM: Utility V, B & A Open V,B & A, Novice B & A, Wildcard Utility, Open & Novice

Saturday PM: Utility V, B & A Open V,B & A, Novice B & A, Seniors and Sub-Novice

POLICIES: Only regular classes are eligible for High Score Awards. Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete in obedience. Upon verification of being in heat by a veterinarian or the Obedience Committee, the entry fee will be refunded if wished. All Breeds may compete, however, they are required to have an ASCA Tracking number. This number may be applied for at the show. Owners/Handlers entering Novice who have titled a dog in any registry in Novice must enter Novice B. Any dog entering Novice or Open who has earned a CD or CDX in any registry must enter Novice B or Open B, as appropriate.

ATTENTION - OBEDIENCE EXHIBITORS. Are you interested to learn where you are losing those points? Would you like some help with your handling? Do you have questions about the obedience classes and how to improve your scores? If so, we will offer an obedience seminar to help answer those questions. :

ASC of Washington Awards: Rosettes will be given for first through fourth place in all stockdog trial classes and flats will be given in all conformation and obedience classes. Special awards and/or rosettes will be awarded above class wins. Cash awards will be awarded to: High in Working Trial Aussie, High in Working Trial Other Breed, Gordy Loyer Memorial, Hank Trusler Memorial, Most Promising Started Australian Shepherd, Most Promising Started Other Breed, and Most Versatile Australian Shepherd.

Most Versatile Australian Shepherd: This award is given to the Australian Shepherd who earns the most points in events Saturday, Sunday or Monday by: obtaining 70% of the available points in the conformation evaluation class, attaining a qualifying score in regular obedience, and a qualifying score in a Started, Open or Advanced Stockdog trial class. If no dog qualifies, no award shall be given. The rules are contained in the ASC of Washington ROM rules.

Patti Peterson Memorial High in Trial Aussie Obedience: The ASCA registered Australian Shepherd who earns the highest qualifying score from any regular obedience class. There will be one award per obedience trial. This award is given in memory of Patti Peterson, long-time Aussie fancier whose contributions to the club and the breed in the foundation days were respected and appreciated.

Hank Trusler High Combined Started Aussie: The ASCA registered Australian Shepherd who earns the highest combined score from any started classes, qualifying or not, in the Stockdog Trials, will earn this award. This award is given in memory of our friend Hank Trusler, a man who graciously opened up the world of stockdog training and trialing to many.

Gordy Loyer Memorial High Combined Stockdog: The dog who earns the highest combined score from all classes and divisions, qualifying or not, in the Stockdog Trials, will receive this award. The ASC of WA sponsors this award in memory of our friend Gordy Loyer, a true friend of the working dog.

Most Promising Started Australian Shepherd: The ASCA registered Australian Shepherd who receives the highest single score, qualifying or not, in the started division, from the Stockdog trials, will receive this award.

Most Promising Started Other Breed: Any breed of dog, other than an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, who receives the highest single score, qualifying or not, in the started division, from the Stockdog trials, will receive this award.

Best Young Stockdog Handler: The junior who receives the single highest score each day, qualifying or not, from the started, open, or advanced division, on any class of stock, in the Stockdog trials, will receive this award. If no junior qualifies it may be awarded from the Junior Stockdog Handler division.
